STEER BUCKED TEENAGE GIRL FLOWN TO ORANGE (Lake Cargelligo)

A teenage girl suffering neck injuries was airlifted to Orange Base Hospital from a rodeo near Lake Cargelligo in the State's Central West last night.

Ambulance officers called the helicopter to a property 45 km east of the township to treat the girl.

The NRMA CareFlight doctor said 15-year-old girl, from Hillston, suffered the neck injury when she was bucked from a steer during a rodeo at the property.

After stabilisation the girl was flown to the hospital where she arrived at 7.30pm, and where she remains in a stable condition.
